

Home Fire Escape Plan



Great work with the escape plan boys. Have you marked in your safe meeting place?

The fridge is a great place to hang your escape plan. Everyone will see it here.

4 things to remember

1. You should always have two ways to get out of your room.
2. Mark your one safe meeting place on your escape plan. It should be outside your home, e.g. your letter box.
3. Put your escape plan somewhere everyone can see it, the fridge is a great place.
4. If you have a friend staying over for the first time, show them your escape plan so they know what to do in a fire emergency. Make sure they know where your safe meeting place is.

TFS kids Create a Fire Escape Plan

- Draw a fire plan of your house.
- Show all the doors and windows that can be used as an exit in an emergency.
- Mark in your smoke alarms.
- Ask an adult for any help to complete this important task.
- Don't forget to include two safe ways out of your sleeping area to your one Safe Meeting Place.
- Place the plan on the fridge.
